Admission Information

Admission Policy

1. Snyder Christian School (SCS) accepts applicants from families that are defined according to the biblical perspective that marriage is between a male and a female.
2. Students who are admitted must agree to adhere to the SCS Statement of Faith and all policies outlined in the *Parent/Student Handbook*.
3. All applicants, Pre-K-6th grades, may be given an entrance exam. SCS requires that the applicant score at grade level or above to be admitted. For those applicants who score below grade level, further testing and assessment will be required in order to determine academic placement.*
4. Admission is based on a combination of several factors: availability of space, application date, testing, interview, and evaluation of prior school records.
5. Final acceptance is based on the board's approval.

**Before testing, parent must provide most current report card.*

Admission Process

Applicants for kindergarten must be 5 years old by September 1. Applicants for first grade must be 6 years old by September 1.

Applicants must:

1. Submit the following information:
 - SCS Application for Admission
 - Medical Authorization Form
 - Birth Certificate
 - Immunization Record
 - Current Report Card (1st-5th Grade)
2. Complete a student screening test (Date TBD)
3. Pay registration fee of \$300
4. Attend Parent Orientation (August)

The grade placement of all new students will be determined by the administration, based on previous records and the testing results.
